MOTION TO CHANGE SPEAKING TIME	To change speaking time	Any time when the floor is open, but NOT during speeches	Can be ruled out by the Chair	No	No	No	No, the Chair decides
POINT OF PERSONAL PRIVILEGE	Need to go out of the room, get water...	Any time when the floor is open, including during speeches	Can be ruled out by the Chair	No	No	No	No, the Chair decides
POINT OF ORDER	To complain about improper Parliamentary procedure, violation of ZAGIMUN Rules	Any time when the floor is open, including speeches, but NOT during the execution of another point of order	Can be ruled out by the Chair	No	No	No	No, the Chair decides
PERLAMENTARY INQUIRY	To get an explanation on a technical point of the ZAGIMUN Rules	Any time when the floor is open, but NOT during speeches	No. The Chair should clarify the matter.	No	No	No	No, the Chair decides
RIGHT TO REPLY	If delegate feel that national/personal integrity has been attacked	AFTER a speech considered offensive	Can be ruled out by the Chair	No	No	No	No, the Chair decides
MOTION FOR CAUCUS	To pass to informal mode of debate	Any time when the floor is opened, but NOT during speeches	Can be ruled out by the Chair	No	No	Requires a Second	Simple majority
MOTION FOR MODERATED CAUCUS	To pass to informal mode of debate, but Representatives remain seated	Any time when the floor is open, but NOT during speeches	Can be ruled out by the Chair	No	No	Requires a Second	Simple majority
MOTION FOR ADJOURNMENT	To suspend the meeting for the day	Any time when the floor is open, but NOT during speeches	Can be ruled out by the Chair	Yes, the Chair's decision may be ruled out by two thirds majority	Yes	Requires a Second	Simple majority
MOTION FOR CLOSURE OF THE DEBATE	To terminate discussion on one agenda item and bring all resolutions and amandments to vote	Any time when the floor is open, but NOT during speeches	Can be ruled out by the Chair	Yes, the Chair's decision may be ruled out by two thirds majority	Yes	Requires a Second	Two-thirds majority
